Broodmares should receive the recommended routine vaccinations through out the year. The above recommendations are in addition to the routine vaccines. If the 10th month of gestation happens to be in the spring, this series can be considered the spring shot series.

DEWORMING SCHEDULE- FOALS

We recommend that foals be dewormed every month starting at 6 weeks of age. The dewormer products should be rotated every month using: ivermectin, oxbendazole, and pyrantol pamoate. Moxidectin should be avoided in young horses until after 1 year of age.
